*Teen to Adult (Teen Plus)	12-17	This access can be granted with the Proxy Invite feature within MyChart.

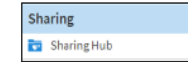


## How Can I Send A Proxy Invitation?

This tip sheet will review how to send a proxy invitation and how to revoke someone's proxy access to your account.

**Note:** The recipient of your proxy invitation must be an existing WellStar patient to accept your invitation.

- Upon logging into your MyChart account, select Sharing Hub from the menu.

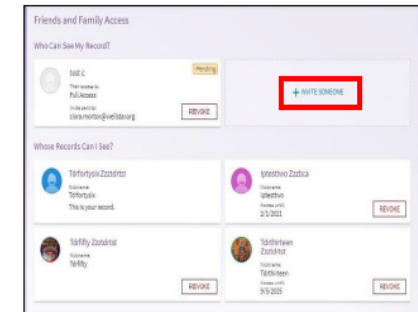


- Select Manage Friends and family access.



- Within the Friends and Family Access section, select Invite Someone.

**Note:** Within the Friends and Family Access screen you can review who has proxy access to your account and accounts you can access. From here, you can revoke access at any time to prevent the listed patients from accessing your MyChart account. You cannot revoke or provide proxy access to accounts you have proxy access to, only your account. To send a new proxy invitation, select Invite Someone
