Note: A student may be placed on probation or suspension, at the discretion of the VPAA, if they fail to successfully complete ENGL 1101 within the first 30 semester hours of enrollment and/or if they fail to successfully complete one core mathematics course (MATH 1101 or higher) within the first 45 semester hours of enrollment at LaGrange College.
